
Dear Mr. Rojas,

Now concerning Gollancz after many discussions I have decided to maintain the contract of Gollancz as it is and you should send me a letter addressed to Gollancz which I will forward. In this letter you should mention that the contract made with Library Publishers by Gollancz is recognized by you and by the same time they can release the monies due to you and half to be payed to Library Publisher or whoever they assign this money and the other half to me through Mr. Robert Sommerville of London.
