Dear Mr. Rojas,

I receive today your registered letter of October 10 and I thank you for the contracts. I am writing you in English because if I understand Spanish I am not able to write it or it would take too much time, but if you would prefer that I correspond with you in French I could do it easily.

Concerning the conditions of representation I agree with you on all points and I thank you.

I have read all your contracts and I have taken the following steps:

Library Publishers contract with Gollancz. While as the contract between Gollancz and Library Publishers is not valid, because in the original contract it is specified that you should sign the contracts which means that they should be drawn between you and the publishers, to make a case out of it would carry such legal expenses that to my opinion it is not worth while. Specially that we would not be sure that we would win, because the spirit of the contract has been maintained and it is only a technical question. I therefore wrote to Gollancz that a new contract on the same terms must be drawn between you and them and signed by you and this will settle the whole matter and I will then release you from Library Publishers.

For Yugoslavia I wrote to Dr. Tothbauer to follow up the contract for me and keep me informed of everything and to notify the

publisher that I was your agent.

Longanesi: This is a little harder as there is already an agent and therefore you should personally notify INTERNATIONAL EDITORS Co. Literary Agency that I am from now on your general agent, when you will have written to them I will then contact them.

Editions du Seuil: I wrote them through my correspondent in Paris notifying that I am your agent and that they must settle a publication date for the book.

Verlag Styria: Dr. Rothbauer writes me that they have sent you the firs 2614, 69 shillings and he does not understand how you haven't received them. I therefore wrote to Dr. Rothbauer asking him to go to Styria publishers and find out through which bank they sent the money. For the other royalties coming out they have applied for permission to the Control of Exchange.

I will keep you informed of the news I will get.
