At this stage comes a coubt in my mind and I wonder if Library ublishers had a contract with you for the world rights? Could you be kind enough

to answer this question. Thanks.

I also know your situation for the British rights with Gollancz, theoretically the amount and royalties to be Pair by Gollancz have to be Tair to Library Tublishers through another agent frien? of mine ( with whom I collaborate sometime ) and on the other hand we do not want to give that amount to Library ublishers because you want see any of it. Asia of thie Particular situation I may or I may not, but still the case exists that I may receive offer for so me rights in other countries or here for movies etc. and I do not know what to do. In my case I have deci-Aed with my lawyers advice to accent any reasonable offer and then nut the money in " escrow ". But all this becomes very complicated and certainly you would not have many advantages of it and eventualy some expenses of lawyers and law suits to recuperate the amounts. Therefore there is toge way out and I would advise you to hip dit studio have grant ther I am doing it for different authors of mine in the list of Library -ublishers like Mrs. Price as Mr. Joaquim Paço a'Arcos, Rev. Father Bruckberger etc.etc. I am freeing them of the contracts with Library Publishers and in this way we can go ahea? and the only Person who will receive any amounts would be you. For instance your money are from Gollancz would be settled very quickly excest the formalities of Exchange .

Therefore I would suggest, if you want, why con't you appoint me your agent and allow me to liberate you from your contract with Library Publisher and concentrate the sale of the rights of your books.
