Dear Mr. Rojas:

Thank you for your kind letter of October 7th; I will answer your questions in the order in which you set them forth:

1. This is an actual publishing house, and not a translation agency, and we wish to publish and manufacture your book in English.
2. Since we are not a translation bureau, no reply necessary.
3. For all rights to your book outside of South America, we will send you in advance our check for \$150.00 in full and complete payment. We will pay for translation here, and produce the book solely at our expense.
4. We prefer world rights outside of South America, for possible subsequent translation into French, German, etc., by us.

Of course, in the event of your acceptance, we will prepare and ask you to sign an agreement embracing the above conditions, also stating that you own the literary property (copyright) and are thereby authorized to assign such rights to us.

We trust we will hear from you soon.
