Dear Mr. Rojas,

We are pleased to inform you that we should like to publish in 1965 "HIJO DE LADRON" and are approaching you with the request that you would be kind enough to grant us the Polish translation rights.


We would suggest our usual terms of agreement: 7 % of the price of a paperbound copy for an edition of 10 000 copies, payable in non-transferable zlotys in Poland within three months of publication. In case of a hard cover edition the royalty shall be based on the hard cover price minus 25 % representing the cost of the hard cover.

We would certainly prefer to be able to offer you a dollar remittance, however considerable foreign currency difficulties prevent us from doing so. In consequence, we have to ask our foreign authors to accept their royalties in zlotys and must say that they generally consent to this proposal.

We do hope that you will find it possible to consider our suggestion favourably and enable us to publish "HIJO DE LADRON" in a Polish translation.
