Dear Mr. Rojas:

Professor Everett W. Hesse of the University of Southern California gave me your address and told me that you would be passing through Los Angeles either in late June or early July. I have an NDEA Institute for forty elementary teachers of Spanish on the lowest possible proficiency level. I had, therefore, planned not to have any lectures in Spanish before the mid-point of our institute around the middle of July. However, it would be wonderful to have you as a lecturer and I would try to get my participants ready to listen to you lecture in Spanish if you could come any evening the week of July 6th to 10th.

Because of the low level of proficiency of our participants I have stated in my contract with Washington that dittoed outlines of evening lectures would be made available to our participants ahead of the lecture so that they can study the content of the lecture under the guidance of native informants and by themselves. Would you be willing to send me such an outline in Spanish ahead of time?

I am, of course, only too glad to leave the topic of your lecture up to you, but would appreciate suggestions.

My budget allows me to offer you \$50 and a small sum for travel expenses.
