Dear Professor Rojas:


We have a vacancy for a Professor of Spanish for one year beginning next September and I have been told that you may be interested in applying for it.

The courses to be taught would be at both the graduate and undergraduate levels and the teaching load would be two courses per quarter. Each course carries 5 hours credit although graduate courses do not normally meet for five hours. We have no Saturday classes. I would like to hear from you concerning the possible areas in which you would feel qualified to teach. While the work would be mostly at an advanced level, it could include a course in intermediate Spanish. We have a good library, and students from the eastern half of the United States. The University owns a number of apartments close to the campus, both furnished and unfurnished, which are regularly available to incoming faculty at reasonable rates. The salary for this post would be about \$11,000 for the academic year.

In case you are not familiar with Atlanta and Emory, I can tell you briefly that we are situated in a pleasant residential suburb of the city and enjoy a comfortable climate. I am enclosing for your interest a brochure which lists our present graduate faculty.

I have spoken to several individuals concerning this vacancy and I hope we will be able to complete our arrangements as rapidly as possible. Your application should include a Curriculum Vitae and you should ask three colleagues including your Chairman to send letters of reference directly to me. I shall be happy to answer any further questions and I look forward to hearing from you.
