Taking advantage of my stay in this country, and knowing the program of the Paramount Company relative to purchase of theaters in South America, I would very much like to have an interview with you, to discuss some business matters that might prove very interesting.

In Chile, my native country (although I am a French writer), there is a great interest for the moving pictures, which no one has so far tried to develop as it should, nor to propagate the interest that grows by itself so spontaneously.

In Santiago de Chile, a city of 840.000 inhabitants, it would be easy to build a large theater which would only cost about \$200.000., of which I would be willing to contribute half, in combination with your goodself.

I know of a place in the capital of Chile - Santiago - which would be ideal for the construction of a Paramount theater, and would like to know whether you are interested in this plan.
