
My dear Sir:

It is very good indeed of Miss Katherine Hughes to write in such terms about us and certainly for any friend of hers we shall do our very best.

As literary agents our practice is to represent our clients on a commission basis, charging on foreign non-fiction books a 20% commission in case the books are delivered to us already translated and ready for publication. If the material sent in needs to be translated or edited before we can submit it to a publisher, we usually do this on an arrangement with the author to share half and half on the royalty and other payments made by publisher. In both cases there is no charge to the author ~~only~~ unless we are able to actually sell the book.
