Juan Pablo Izquierdo, the Chilean conductor of international fame, has now chosen Europe as his domicile.

His career is best illustrated by reviews from performances all over Europe, the USA, Latin America and Israel.

As from this year-1976-he has been appointed Chief conductor of the Gulbenkian Orchestra in Lisbon. He is also the musical Director of the annual "Testimonial Festival" of Jerusalem, and he conducts several festivals with contemporary music as their central theme.

Juan Pablo Izquierdo, a superb conductor of the classics and romantics, is a very much involved advocate of modern works which, but for his intense interest, may not have seen daylight in a public performance.

Apart from his qualities as a musician Juan Pablo Izquierdo, who conducts without a baton, evokes invariably an inspired response from the internationally famous orchestras and soloists, and- least but not last- from the audiences, to whom he projects his attractive personality and musicianship.
